The death rate for cancer patients in Washington, DC is more than seven percent higher than the rest of the country, according to the District's Health Department. The EagleBank Foundation's Fifth Annual Fight Against Breast Cancer Golf Tournament was held to raise money for breast cancer patients in the community.

Don Rogers, founding partner of law firm Shulman Rogers, is the Chairman of the EagleBank Foundation, a 501(c)(3) organization. Giving back to the community is important to all of the attorneys at Shulman Rogers, and this tournament is a great way to get involved in a very worthy cause."

The money is distributed to area hospitals. From research to support groups, hospitals such as Suburban, Providence Shady Grove, and Washington Hospital Center have all benefited from the tournament and from the community's overall support.

"The high cancer rate in the Washington DC area is a clear sign that more needs to be done to prevent this disease from impacting the lives of our neighbors, colleagues, friends and loved ones," said
