Strategies and Solutions from Work Visas to Greencards

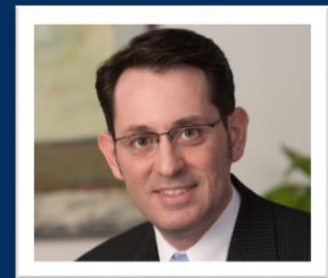
